**Salisbury House Foundation announces  
2013 Shakespeare on the Lawn Program**

Des Moines, IA (November 29, 2012) — The Salisbury House Foundation is pleased to announce the return of *Shakespeare on the Lawn at Salisbury House* in summer 2013. Repertory Theater of Iowa (RTI) will offer William Shakespeare's comedy, *A Midsummer Night's Dream*, on June 20<sup>th</sup>, 21<sup>st</sup>, 22<sup>nd</sup> and 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2013 at Des Moines' most beloved Shakespearean setting, Salisbury House & Gardens. Rain dates are scheduled for June 24<sup>th</sup> and 25<sup>th</sup>. The dates for this delightful summer play were chosen specifically to include both the Summer Solstice and June's Full Moon, adding an extra dose of magic to an already spectacular offering.

"I am delighted to once again partner with Repertory Theater of Iowa to present *Shakespeare on the Lawn at Salisbury House* next summer," says Salisbury House Foundation Executive Director J. Eric Smith. "I am proud to claim these experienced Central Iowa artists as creative partners, and can think of no better venue to see Shakespeare than Salisbury House. Our grounds are shaded by ancient oaks, and lined with flower beds evoking the English gardens of Shakespeare's era. Our actors and sets will be framed by the House's distinctive English Tudor stone work, Gothic arches and Carolean brickwork. Our furnishings, library and archives contain many, many items from Shakespeare's time, including a complete second folio edition of the Bard's plays from 1632, along with wooden ceiling beams and wall panels that adorned English homes while Shakespeare's career was in its heyday."

The Salisbury House Foundation is grateful for the lead gift awarded by Principal Financial Group for *Shakespeare on the Lawn at Salisbury House*, which will also support a Shakespeare Summer Camp for children, and two additional special "one night only" RTI performances at Salisbury House in February and May 2013. Tickets for *A Midsummer Night's Dream* are \$25 for adults, \$20 for Salisbury House members and \$5 for students aged 12-18; admission for children 11 and under is free. Lawn chair seating will be provided. Guests are welcome to bring blankets for picnic style seating.
